7.1.10 COMMEMORATIVE DAYS

The College inculcates tolerance, communal harmony, and inclusivity among the students and staff by **celebrating the following national and international commemorative days, events, and festivals.**

1. Relevant talks by eminent academicians and scholars are organized to celebrate the **birth anniversary of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar** (14 April), the **International Human Rights Day** (10 December).
2. Every year, **International Women’s Day** (8 March) is celebrated by organizing programs on gender equality and justice, the Girl Up Society of the College.
3. **World Environment Day** (5 June) is observed with the planting of saplings. As a part of the **Earth Hour Movement**, encourage the students and staff to turn off the non-essential electric lights. **Vruskho Rakshitha Rakshithaha Week** (1-7 July) is organized by administering a Green Pledge to the students.
4. Cultural programs are organized on the occasion of **Independence Day and Republic Day** and relevant talks by eminent academicians are organized.
5. The birth anniversary of S. Radhakrishnan (5 September), is celebrated enthusiastically by the students as **Teachers’ Day**.
6. Every year programs are organized on **World Cancer Day, World No Tobacco Day, World AIDS Day, World Oral Health Day, Oral Hygiene Day, Orthodontic Day, Prosthodontic Day, CONS & ENDO Day, and World Immunization Day**.
