Basic responsibilities of Ethical Committee:

- *To ensure the competent review and evaluation of all the ethical aspects of research projects received in an objective manner.
- *To protect the safety, rights and well being of the potential research participants.
- *To conduct scientific evaluation and ensure technical appropriateness of the proposed study.
- *To ensure that universal ethical values and international scientific standards are expressed in terms of local community values and customs.
- *To assist in the development and the education of a research community responsive to local health care requirements.
- *Creation, developing revising and implementing ethical guidelines (SOPs).

Establishing and Constituting the Institutional Ethics Committee

Purpose:

To establish and constitute the Institutional Ethical Committee for Lenora Institute of Dental Sciences Rajanagaram as per ICMR Guidelines, Schedule Y and ICH-GCP.

Steps towards the IEC meeting-I :

- 1.Prefixed dates for routine IEC meetings
- 2.Submissions made by researchers in keeping with the requirements of the IEC's SOP(Standard Operating Procedures).
- 3.Finalising primary and secondary reviewers
- 4.The proposals circulated to members giving sufficient time for review.

Steps towards the IEC meeting-II

- 5.Members undertake the review
- 6.Meeting of the IEC
- 7.Discussion at the IEC
- 8.Decision made
- 9.The decisions and the reasons are communicated to the researchers.

Responsibility :

Principal/Dean is responsible to initiate the process of constitution of Institutional Ethical Committee.

Procedure :

*Principal/Dean will select and nominate the Chairman(preferably from outside the institute) and member secretary(from institute) for IEC.

*IEC will be constituted by the Principal/Dean in consultation with the Chairman.

* Principal/Dean will invite the members to join the ethical committee.

*Principal/Dean will designate and instruct chairman of IEC to conduct the regular proceedings of IEC.

* Principal/Dean will review the function of IEC at regular interval.

The regular members of the committee will include at least 7 individuals as follows:

1. Two-Three persons from basic medical sciences area,
2. Two-Three persons from clinical side,
3. One social scientist/representative of 'non-governmental' voluntary agency/philosopher/ethicist/theologian,
4. One legal person,
5. One lay person from the community,
6. Member secretary,
7. Where ever required the expert person on particular subject would be invited.


